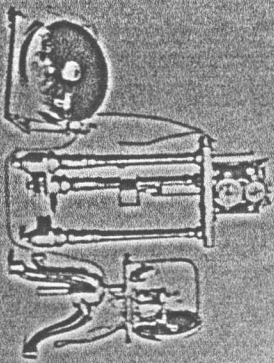

J. B. Watson once said that Zing-Yang Kuo enjoyed "shocking the old fogies" in the field of animal behaviorism. When *The Dynamics of Behavior Development: An Epigenetic View* was first published in 1967, it shocked many students as well, provoking lively discussions on a number of campuses both here and abroad. In this supplemented edition of his still controversial treatise, Kuo describes the leading conceptual issues in the study of animal behavior in a manner that remains fresh, clear, and forthright. Gilbert Gottlieb has contributed a new preface and a short biography, and has included Kuo's last published article, in which he calls for the establishment of multidisciplinary centers for developmental studies on the behavioral, physiological, and anatomical levels of analysis.
